# **First Aid Training**

A First Aid training course was run in May and this was attended by twelve people who had expressed an interest. The course included instruction on the use of a defibrillator.

#### Defibrillator

There has been a delay in the supply of the defibrillator unit due to the batteries being on back-order. The cabinet has been fitted to the wall of the Moore-Stevens Hall, and the electrical connections made so that this can be heated and lit. (Batteries that aren't cold perform better). We expect the defibrillator unit to be delivered shortly. Once operational, the necessary PIN to open the cabinet will be held centrally so that anyone phoning for an ambulance will be given that information in appropriate cases.

#### **Pot Holes**

There has been some progress on getting these filled in, but new ones appear regularly. Anyone can report them along with other road problems, anonymously if you wish, using the link <u>https://new.devon.gov.uk/roadsandtransport/report-a-problem</u> There is also a link to this Devon CC page on

the Parish Council's own web site under the 'Services' tab.

## **Town and Parish Fund**

This is a grant that the Council can apply for and the amount available is linked to the number of parishioners on the Electoral Roll. If you have any ideas for a <u>small</u> project that could be considered, please let one of the Parish Councillors know. The reason for the 'small' is that the amount available for 2017/18 is only £170. In the past, the Fund has been used to buy plants for the Millennium Green and more recently, by rolling over the previous year's grant we arranged the First Aid training.

The next Parish Council meeting is on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> July 2017 at 19:30 in the Moore-Stevens Hall.

## FIRST AID COURSE

A first aid course run by 'First with Iain 'was held in May for 12 trainees from the village. We all learnt some valuable skills, which we hope we don't have to use. We all succeeded in obtaining a QA Level 2 award in 'Emergency First aid at Work' certificate, with some going on to train for the next level. Many thanks to the Parish council for using their Town and Parish Fund to subsidise this training. Some donations in lieu of fees have been put towards a Devon Air ambulance fund.
